Research and development of our wheelchairs takes place on our innovative test track while extensive fundraising efforts are planned and executed to fund program expenses.

Manufacturing South and East Asia

The wheelchair frames and all associated parts are manufactured, boxed, and prepared for shipment by our factory partners.

Transport By Land and Sea

A shipping container of approximately 510 boxed kits of wheelchairs is loaded onto a cargo ship or freight train, depending on its destination.

Wheelchair Distribution

Wheelchairs are distributed at ceremonies—large or small—or are distributed individually as needed. The distribution partner documents the process and sends distribution reports to us.

Distribution Training

To ensure that our wheelchairs are assembled and fitted correctly, we require all distribution partners to undergo a comprehensive hybrid training course.

Unloading & Assembling

Local distribution partner staff and volunteers unload the container and assemble the wheelchairs. Working with local governments, charitable organizations, churches, and medical professionals, our partner assesses the needs in their community and identifies potential wheelchair recipients.

Port of Destination Customs

Upon reaching port at its destination country, the container is received by our local distribution partner, who works with local authorities to clear customs. Our partner then arranges to transport the container to their warehouse.
